Eugene Bozza

Eugene Bozza (1905-1991) studied composition, conducting, and violin at the Paris Conservatoire. He is best known in the brass world for his solo and chamber music. His works using brass instruments include: *Ballade* for trombone and piano, *Concertino* for tuba and piano, *Trois Pièces* for trombone ensemble, *Sur Les Cimes*, *En Forêt* and *En Irlande* for horn and piano, *Rustiques* and *Badinage* for trumpet and piano, *Dialogue* for two trumpets and *Quintet* for brass quintet.

His music for winds shows great familiarity with the capabilities of the instruments, often demanding a great deal of technical skill, without losing the expressive, melodic style typical of 20th century French music.

Rustiques is one of the most popular contemporary works for trumpet and piano. It has been performed and recorded by countless soloists ranging from college and university students to the top professionals around the world.

The opening section contains several cadenzas. A wide notational range and bursts of multiple tonguing are employed to showcase the control and flexibility of the trumpet player. The *Allegro* section is reminiscent of an Italian *tarantella* with quick fingers and light articulations needed.

The original piano part has been scored for a brass quintet with the two trumpet players performing on mellow sounding flugelhorns. This creates a cohesive sound within the accompanying quintet and allows for the brilliant sound of the trumpet to float over the ensemble. For an even more blended sound, a euphonium could be used rather than a trombone.

The arranger would like to thank Mr. Jean Leduc of Alphonse Leduc & Cie. for granting permission to arrange this wonderful piece for soloist and brass quintet. Leduc is the publisher of the trumpet and piano version. It is of the highest quality and a major work in the repertoire for the trumpet.
