As a composer, she is known internationally for her fine choral writing, both sacred and secular. Many choral organizations throughout North America have commissioned her work for special occasions, and increasing numbers of choirs have devoted entire concerts to her music.

A number of her choral works have brass accompaniments, but she has also written solo pieces for trumpet as well as for piano, organ, and violin.
