Place l.h. fingers firmly on strings behind dampers (2, 3, 4, 5 on pitches: F4, E4, D4, C4). Slowly slide l.h. fingers down strings inside piano. (A mixture of choked tones and various harmonic overtones are to be produced.) Reach the limit of your arm's reach in m. 8 and gradually slide back to the beginning position (they are grouped in measures of 7 and 5). Continue following the arrows in this fashion.


