Another Mission: Secret is a sequel to the *Mission: Secret*. Like its predecessor, this chart uses all the qualities of a classic spy tune: 12-bar blues form, catchy bass riff, simple melody and suspenseful dynamics.

After a short, attention grabbing introduction, the piece moves into the bass line, followed by the melody played in the 1st trumpet. The bass line includes an important lick, like the one in measure 18, often throughout the piece. This lick plays an important role by filling in the time during the long notes in the melody, so players should not be afraid to bring it out a little each time it is performed.

The middle contrasting section beginning at measure 63 should be played with exaggerated dynamic contrast in the long tones to help increase the suspenseful feeling.

Ryan Meeboer is a music educator who obtained his degree through the Ontario Institute for Studies in Education at the University of Toronto. As a composer, he has written and arranged many pieces for students in concert and jazz bands, and has also composed and arranged pieces for small university combos. As a performer, he has had experience in several groups, including concert and stage bands, chamber choir, vocal jazz ensemble, pop groups, acoustic duets, and the Hamilton based swing group, The Main Swing Connection.

Focusing on music education and theory (including composition and orchestration), he attended McMaster University to achieve his honours degree in music.
