Chenonceau Castle

Chenonceau Castle is a water castle and a Renaissance masterpiece. It is located in the Indre-et-Loire department of the Centre-Val de Loire region in France.

The castle is visited by 800,000 tourists a year, making it the most visited castle in France after Versailles. It is also called the Château des Dames.
