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Justin Bland

Applauded for his “gleaming, dancing trumpet” and “immaculate intonation” (*The Boston Globe*) as well as for his “dazzling virtuosity” (*Grunion Gazette*), the American trumpeter **Justin Bland** is a highly sought-after solo/principal Baroque trumpeter. As a highly sought-after solo/principal Baroque trumpeter deemed “most likely to win a gold medal, if music had Olympics” (*Boston Globe*), Dr. Bland has performed with several leading North American ensembles including American Bach Soloists, Apollo’s Fire, Bach Collegium San Diego, Boston Baroque, Handel and Haydn Society, Washington Bach Consort, and many others. He has also played in South America with Ensemble Barroco de Bogotá.

Now living in Denmark, Justin continues performing as both a soloist and ensemble musician, combining ongoing North American engagements with new collaborations with leading Baroque ensembles in Scandinavia and the rest of Europe. In Europe he has played Baroque trumpet with Arte dei Suonatori, Akademie für Alte Musik Berlin, Croatian Baroque Ensemble, Händelfestspielorchester Halle, Göteborg Baroque, Les Arts Florissants, Wrocław Baroque Ensemble, and many more. He has also played Baroque trumpet with modern instrument ensembles including Camerata Lyckensis, Camerata Nordica, Esbjerg Ensemble, Kammerakademie Potsdam, and Karlskrona Kammarorkester.

Justin also plays recorder, and has performed on that instrument with ensembles including Croatian Baroque Ensemble, Enghave Barok, Finnish Baroque Orchestra, Göttinger Barockorchester, Nivalis Barokk, and Orkester Nord. Furthermore, Justin is also a countertenor and has sung with Apollo’s Fire and Opera Cleveland, among others.

Justin specializes in early music, most notably in difficult high-register music for Baroque trumpet; for example, he has played Bach’s Brandenburg Concerto No. 2 with groups in Canada, Colombia, Denmark, Germany, Portugal, Serbia, Spain, Sweden, and the USA (in 2021 he played it twelve times in five countries).

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Thanks to the early music revival, more and more players are playing the natural trumpet, making the natural trumpet ensemble increasingly more relevant to present-day musicians. While some contemporary composers are writing for early instruments, there seems to be considerably less focus on composing for the natural trumpet. To fill in this gap, I have written several short pieces for natural trumpet ensemble. One of the compositional challenges of writing for natural trumpets, and perhaps the main reason for such a lack of contemporary material written for these instruments, is that such instruments are limited to notes of the harmonic series. To help overcome this, each piece presented here is written for at least two different pitched trumpets; the different combinations of crookings for each piece allow for a greater harmonic variety between each composition. The ensemble size for each piece varies, ranging from two to four trumpets, sometimes with and sometimes without timpani.

Since these compositions were written to provide modern-day players of the natural trumpet with contemporary material that is unique, accessible, and functional, their technical demands have purposefully been kept reasonable. The range of each trumpet part rarely ascends higher than the twelfth harmonic, and extended techniques have generally been avoided (with the most unusual technique being ascending harmonic-series *glissandi*). Much of the musical interest comes from the rhythmic surprises and the atypical harmonies arising from the simultaneous use of different pitched trumpets.

Because of the natural trumpet's general intonation tendencies, trumpeters performing these works must carefully listen and make adjustments based on the unique harmonies of each individual piece, even though such adjustments may, at times, be somewhat counterintuitive due to the non-standard crooking combinations. It is helpful to keep in mind a piece of advice given by Edward Tarr's in the third volume of his *The Art of Baroque Trumpet Playing* method: "Good intonation is a matter of democracy and fair play, not of being right!" When performing the initial tuning for each composition, I suggest choosing a solution that allows for the most ease in making the consonances sound as in tune as possible. Fine adjustments can also be made during the course of performance as one might do when playing standard literature on the natural trumpet. Consequently, these pieces are not only interesting performance material, but also good material for developing a more refined sense of natural trumpet ensemble intonation.

Although the pieces presented here were conceived for natural trumpets pitched at the "Baroque pitch"-standard of A₄=415 Hz, they can be performed at a variety of pitch levels, including A₄=440 Hz, A₄=430 Hz, and A₄=392 Hz, depending on the musical situation and desire of the performers. Additionally, as is the case with historical compositions for natural trumpets, these compositions can be performed on modern valved instruments.
