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## Toccatina and Fugue in D minor BWV 565

Johann Sebastian Bach  
*Arranged by David Marlatt*

**THE WORK:** One of the most famous solo organ compositions of Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) is his Toccata and Fugue in D minor. The organ works of Bach came in the Weimar period of his life. The forms he wrote for were borrowed and adapted from his predecessors such as Frescobaldi and Buxtehude. The toccata was designed as a virtuosic showpiece to demonstrate the brilliant technique of an organist. The fugue was an intricate network of contrapuntal voices on a single brief theme, one voice following the other at measured intervals. This work consists of a toccata and fugue then ends with a short toccata.

**THE TRANSCRIPTION:** The continuation of the musical line is crucial in this contrapuntal work. Careful matching of articulation, dynamic and style must also be done by the trumpets to successfully add their colour to the grand expanse of the organ. The pedal work in the organ part has been greatly simplified to facilitate ease of playing.
