First Suite in Eb Chaconne

Gustav Holst

Arranged by David Marlatt

THE WORK: Gustav Holst is a British composer who studied composition at Oxford where he met Ralph Vaughan Williams. It was this influence that altered Holst's compositional style which began to include English folk songs. Besides composing, Holst played and had a love for the trombone and therefore he knew the expressive capabilities of brass choir and the band. He was appalled by the limited repertory available for these instrumental ensembles and was determined to make the band a serious concert medium. His *First Suite in Eb* was the first significant step in that direction. All three movements of the Suite contain folk songs or a strong folk song character. The *Chaconne* is the first of the movements.

THE TRANSCRIPTION: The selection of the various pitches of trumpets was to introduce a wider range of colours to the brass ensemble. The Eb Trumpet acts as a transition sound from the Piccolo to the Cornets. The Eb plays some of the solo lines leaving the highest and lightest parts to the Piccolo. The Cornet was chosen to better blend with the horns and euphonium making an inner choir. Alternate parts have been provided but for the best balance in sound and colour, the suggested instruments work best.
